Important Information About This Application

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Basic** - Students must be a Citizen or Naturalized Citizen of the United States, and have demonstrated the dispositions that are most valued at Wooster, among which are to be “gentle, generous, truthful, kind, and brave” - characteristics that we associate with future leaders and change-makers in our society.
- **Academic** – Successful applicants will have an academic record which places them at or near the top of their current school class, with the potential to become the kind of thinker that Wooster aspires to develop.
- **Athletics/Fine and Performing Arts** - It is important that Rudenstine Scholarship applicants have a demonstrated passion in an area outside of academics, and a track record that shows their passion leading to hard work, resiliency and achievement in that area.
- **Leadership/Service** – While this is often an area in which young people are just emerging, candidates for the Rudenstine Scholarships must have the potential to be leaders and change-makers on the Wooster campus and beyond.

Application Sections, Scoring & Helpful Hints:

- **Essay:** Write an essay from the prompt on page 3. (500 words maximum).
- **Extra-Curricular Form:** Focus on participation and leadership experiences, athletic achievements, academic awards, fine or performing arts recognition, and community involvement.
- **Short-Answer Questions:** Use this space to tell us more about how you've personally benefited by staying active – both in and out of your area of passion, and in and out of school.
- **Two Letters of Recommendation:** Approach coaches, teachers, school administrators, youth group leaders or others in your community and have them write recommendation letters so the judges can learn a little bit more about you. There is a two-page maximum for each letter.
